Executive Order N-7-22 Well Permit Request Process: Morgan Campbell reported that WDWA GSA received two well permit applications. Executive Order N-7-22 requires GSAs to approve new well drilling permits to ensure the new well will not harm the GSA's ability to manage groundwater sustainably. After discussion, on motion of Jeremy Blackwell, and seconded by Rod Steifvater, the Board authorized WDWA GSA staff to process and approve routine well permit applications that are consistent with any adopted management actions or projects adopted by WDWA GSA. GEI Data Management System Grant Budget Overrun Payment Morgan Campbell reported that GEI Consultants requested all Kern County Subbasin GSAs cost-share paying a \$140,398.00 budget overrun to develop the Kern County Subbasin SGMA Data Management System (DMS). GEI wrote off 50% of the budget overrun (\$71,977.50) with \$71,977.50 remaining for the 22 GSA entities in the Subbasin to equally split. After discussion, on motion of Rod Stiefvater, seconded by Bernard Pugét, and unanimously carried, the Board authorized a one-time payment of \$3,281.70 from WDWA GSA to GEI to cover the cost of the DMS budget overrun on the following roll call vote:

SWRCB staff announced an updated hearing schedule that postponed Kern County Subbasin's SGMA probationary hearing date to January 2025. No Board action was taken.
